All of year 10 will be in the lecture theatre with the English team for the duration of periods 6 and 7

- Tuesday 8th May: Year 11 will be completing a 'Walking,talking,mock' next Tuesday during maths' lessons. This will help students to understand exam processes and techniques needed in the non-calculator paper.
- Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> May: All Y11 students will complete Geography revision during P7. There will also be a session running from 5-6pm for some students. There will therefore be some changes to Y11 enrichment arrangements which ABE will email out in advance of the day. The 40 minute Y11 sessions will become 30min, 30min (3-4pm), 1hour (4-5pm). The Y11 students will be involved in Geography masterclasses from 4-5pm (6pm in some cases) with an external visitor from Green Light. There is an exception, one group of Geography (11A2) will have Science instead from 4-5pm
- Monday 14th May: external exams start, S01, the library and the lecture theatre will be out of use for the whole exam period
