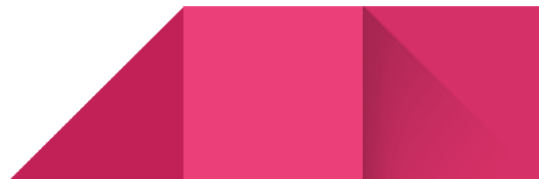


## Events that have taken place this week
